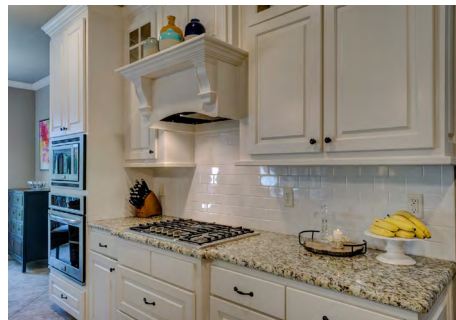

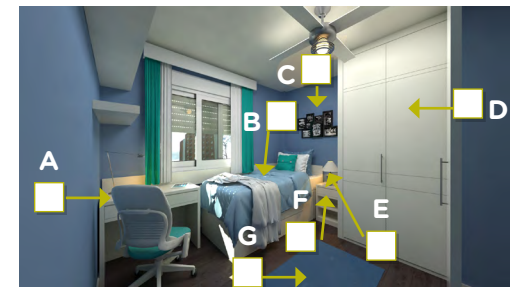

Hi Paul!

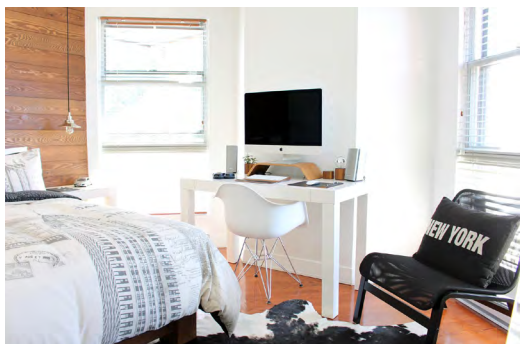
