Must-see Attractions in BA

Buenos Aires is a fascinating cosmopolitan city. There are dozens of reasons to visit this unique city, but visiting its majestic buildings is probably one of the most interesting. Among the must-see attractions you can find, there are two iconic places near each other that you can't miss.

The Pink House (Casa Rosada)

This emblematic pink palace is opposite Plaza de Mayo and is the seat of the Argentine president and the national government. In this building, there are a lot of rooms, halls and galleries. Also, there are three beautiful patios. In some of the rooms, there are different exhibitions related to Argentina's history and culture. Behind the Pink House, there is a museum that has a mural by a famous painter and many presidential objects.

The Metropolitan Cathedral

The Metropolitan Cathedral is the Catholic Church's main site in Argentina. Like the Pink House, it is opposite Plaza de Mayo. The building's facade looks like a Greek Temple: there are twelve columns at the front that represent the twelve apostles of Christ. Inside the cathedral, there are lots of images of saints



and virgins. For example, you can find the image of the virgin of Buen Ayre, after whom the city was named. The Mausoleum* of San Martín and the Unknown Soldier is one of the most visited places in the cathedral. Also, there is a museum called Pope Francis Museum in honour of the Pope.

*mausoleum: a large impressive tomb (=stone structure in which someone is buried). Source: Macmillan Dictionary.


